
Purpose of the Initiative

Alert the public about the effects of ongoing and proposed USAF training flights over the Chiricahua-Peloncillo Mountain Region



TWO GOALS OF THIS INITIATIVE

- 1. COMPEL USAF to <u>FOLLOW EXISTING</u> FEDERAL AGENCY REGULATIONS for Current Training Flights
- 2. STOP UNNEEDED <u>FUTURE EXPANSION</u> of high-decibel, low-level military flights over the "TOMBSTONE MOA"



MOA HISTORY and CURRENT STATUS

Tombstone MOA created in the 1970s.... When local populations were much smaller

USAF training flights were fewer and followed existing rules and regulations for decades....

CURRENT MOA FLIGHT REGULATIONS

- No Dropping of Chaff—Fully Prohibited
- No Flares dropped from below 5,000 ft. AGL
- No Sonic-Boom-producing flights below 30,000 ft.
- No Training flights below 500 ft. AGL
- No flights closer than 500 ft. from any structure/person
- No flights after 9 p.m.
- No flights allowed over Portal AZ /Animas, NM areas.

SOMETHING HAS CHANGED...


More than 200 Nuisance Flight Reports filed by area residents since USAF Announced its Flight Expansion Plan.

WHAT HAPPENED?

- MUCH LARGER POPULATION in TOMBSTONE MOA
- MORE ECONOMIC ACTIVITY
- MORE FLIGHTS, FREQUENT VIOLATIONS OF MOA REGULATIONS IN PAST 2 YEARS

REPORT ALL NUISANCE FLIGHTS

IT'S A NUISANCE FLIGHT if you consider it to be a NUISANCE—regardless of regulations

THE LAW: Federal Aviation Regulation 91.119 specifies that aircraft may not be operated closer than 500 feet to any person, vessel, vehicle or structure.

Easy-To-Fill-Out NUISANCE FLIGHT REPORT FORM

Peacefulchiricahuaskies/report

Provide if available:

- 1. Type of Aircraft
- 2. Time and Date of Flight
- 3. Location of Flight (GPS best)
- 4. Reason for Complaint (Noise, Danger)

Reports Automatically Sent to all Airbases

THE NEW TRAINING FLIGHT EXPANSION PROPOSAL

ACTIVITY EXISTING REGULATIONS PROPOSED REGULATIONS*

TIME OF OPERATIONS: 6AM - 9PM Daily

LOWEST FLIGHT ALTITUDE: 500 Feet ABOVE GROUND

LOWEST SUPERSONIC FLIGHT: 30,000 Feet ABOVE GROUND

LOWEST FLARE RELEASE: 5,000 Feet ABOVE GROUND

LOWEST CHAFF RELEASE: NOT ALLOWED

FLIGHTS OVER PORTAL, AZ: NOT ALLOWED

6AM - 9PM Daily

100 feet Above Ground

5,000 feet Above Ground

2,000 feet Above Ground

2,000 Feet Above Ground

ALLOWED (boundary expanded)


* Alternative #1 No Action Alternative

Alternative #2 Preferred Alternative (see above)

Alternative #3 Identical to #2 except no boundary expansion to include Portal, AZ

Alternative #4 Identical to #2 except the Lowest Supersonic Flight is increased to

10,000 feet above ground from 5,000 feet

Impacts from Expanded USAF Air Operations

What are the benefits for local residents and communities?

No Tangible Benefits Reported by USAF At Animas Public Meeting

What are the negatives for local residents and communities?

- Loss of quality of life and safety
- Stress on personal health and well-being, loss of privacy
- Reduction in real estate values (disclosures, tax reductions, lost sales).
- Reduction in tourism due to loss of quiet and wildlife in recreation areas
- Disruption of livestock and pet activities due to extreme noise levels.
- Increased risk of wildfires from flares, crashes
- Biodiversity damage from chaff releases
- Damage to structures caused by sonic booms

OSHA LEGAL LIMITS ON NOISE EXPOSURE

Any noise above 90 decibels in the workplace requires employer-provided hearing protection.

F-16 at 500 feet above ground at 500 mph produces 120 decibels of noise.



FAA RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FLIGHTS NEAR NOISE-SENSITIVE AREAS

FAA Visual Flight Rules (VFR)

"All aircraft must maintain a minimum altitude of 2,000 feet above the surface of lands and waters administered by the NPS, UFWS, or USFS Wilderness areas."



WHAT IS A "SONIC BOOM"?

When sound barrier broken @ 761 mph

F-16 or F-35 attaining supersonic speed at 5,000 feet AGL Would produce a sonic boom of 200 decibels





CHAFF RELEASE

Countermeasure to confuse enemy radar



NEW PROPOSAL WOULD ALLOW CHAFF DROP FROM 2,000 FEET above ground

(Currently: NOT ALLOWED IN TOMBSTONE MOA)





New Proposal would allow dropping of flares from 2,000' above ground

(Currently: 5,000')

Countermeasure against heat-seeking missiles

Two Major Forest Fires linked to flare releases



DO F-16s/F-35s EVER CRASH?

"Six F-16s have been involved in accidents in 2023. About three Fighting Falcons have been totaled each year on average for the past decade."

THREATS TO WILDLIFE

SE Arizona, SW New Mexico have 140 ESA-Listed plant and animal species

Low-level, High-Decibel Training flights can "adversely modify designated critical habitats" for ESA-Listed species—USFWS




USFWS APPROVALS REQUIRED FOR DISRUPTION OF HABITAT



....Proposed activities must not be "likely to jeopardize the continued existence of listed species or adversely modify designated critical habitats."

The USAF must consult with ALL agencies whose lands are affected by the new proposal.
