
- a. Castle Dome Heliport is located within R-2307. Used primarily for UAS test and training activities.
- b. Restricted Area R-2307 is never released to the public in its entirety. The continuous presence of unexploded munitions in various positions mandates a 7,000 feet minimum flight altitude over the area for the entire reporting period.
